RESOLUTION NO. 126 S. 2013

**A RESOLUTION REITERATING THE CALL OF BATANGAS CITY SANGGUNIANG
PANLUNGSOD WOMEN LEGISLATORS IN SUPPORT TO VIOLENCE
AGAINST WOMEN**

WHEREAS, under Section 16 RA 7160 or the Local Government Code states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, it is the thrust of our Nation and as well as the City to improve public morals including the basic and strong sector, the Women Sector and recognizing its vital contribution in building a strong community;

WHEREAS, one of the controversial issues which have been in the news lately regarding allegedly rape case filed by a co-councilor against another councilor is one issue related to violence on women that needs attention and support for the call for justice;

WHEREAS, after this incident some of the Councilors of Batangas City have been experiencing violence through harassment in words through social media that in some way could be traumatic in its own way and can bring effect in personal lives;

WHEREAS, despite different laws that have been passed national or local still who have been victims of sexual abuse, physical abuse/maltreatment/battering, illegal recruitment, involuntary prostitution, armed conflict, human trafficking, detention, emotionally distressed, sexually exploited, voluntary committed/surrendered, and neglected victims of disaster;


WHEREAS, the Women Legislators of Batangas City has a strong stand that we are after Violence Against Women in words or in deeds.


