RESOLUTION NO. 36 S. 2020

**RESOLUTION URGING ALL PUJBODA, TODA AND MARINE VESSELS TO WEAR
FACE MASK AND PROVIDE HAND SANITIZER FOR PASSENGERS ON BOARD
FOR THE PREVENTIONS AGAINST 2019 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS**

WHEREAS, the pathogen or new virus, belonging to the coronavirus family, is officially called 2019-nCoV and believed to have emerged from an illegal market for wildlife in Wuhan, capital of the Central Chinese province of Hubei, the epicenter of the Novel Coronavirus (2019 nCoV) outbreak in December 2019;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak sparked by the new virus in China that has spread to more than a dozen countries as a “Global Health Emergency”, an international emergency as an “Extraordinary Event” that constitutes a risk to other countries and required a coordinated international response;

WHEREAS, DOH Secretary Francisco Duque III confirms first case of Coronavirus in the Philippines, to mention 18 are in Metro Manila, four (4) in Central Visayas, three (3) in Western Visayas and one (1) each in MIMAROPA, Eastern Visayas, Northern Mindanao and Davao; (Please refer to DOH Updates)

- **WHEREAS**, LGU must take the necessary precautionary measures to halt the spread of the virus;


