WHEREAS, in order to better serve the populace and in concurrence to the clamor of the school and its barangay officials, the City Mayor along with the Schools Division Superintendent, is requesting to separate the two campuses of Sto. Niño Elementary School;

WHEREAS, the same is consistent with Republic Act No. 9155 known as the “Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001” that the school shall have a single aim of providing the best possible basic education for all learners;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled to support the separation of two campuses, the Sto. Niño Main Campus and the Niño Jesus Elementary School in Barangay Sto. Niño, Batangas City.

Letter request from the City Mayor regarding the request for a Resolution supporting the separation of Sto. Niño Main Campus and the Niño Jesus Elementary School in Barangay Sto. Niño, Batangas City

COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The subject request for the passage of a resolution was referred to the Committee on Education for its consideration during a Special Session held on March 19, 2020.

Sto. Nino Elementary School is currently hosting more than 300 students in its Sto. Nino Proper campus and in its Sitio Papayahan campus. In order to fully address the needs and demands of both campuses, the Schools Division Superintendent, Dr. Felizardo O. Bolaños, is requesting the Sangguniang Panlungsod for a resolution of support in order to separate the two campuses so that both of the campuses can have their own budget, school head, and personnel.
