WHEREAS, the continuity of public services is essential in order to assist the community in recovering from the adverse effects of disaster; the development of the Public Service Continuity Plan will ensure that it is possible to continue to provide quality and much-needed service to the public, especially during times of disaster or any sort of disruption;

WHEREAS, the Public Service Continuity Plan (PSCP) details how Batangas City can ensure the continuity of essential functions and public services in the case of any event or incident which can disrupt normal operations. The plan will be adopted across all process and procedures to ensure continuity of government services in case of any disruptions;

WHEREAS, the City Government intends to promulgate an efficient and effective public service continuity management system in safeguard human lives, enable quick and effective decision making and communication between different agencies under the City Government of Batangas and improve organizational resilience, internally and externally, to quickly recover from disruptions and provide critical services to public and other stakeholders;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it hereby resolves to approve the implementation of the Batangas City Public Service Continuity Plan.

BATANGAS CITY PUBLIC SERVICE CONTINUITY PLAN FOR THE CDRRMO.

COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS

The subject request for the passage of a resolution was referred to the Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations for its consideration during the Regular Session on January 4, 2022.

The public service continuity plan (PSCP) details how Batangas City can ensure the continuity of essential functions and public services in the case of any event or incident which can disrupt normal operations. The plan will be adopted across all processes and procedures to ensure continuity of government services in case of any disruptions.

The development of the Public Service Continuity Plan is important to ensure continued performance of essential functions through timely and orderly recovery, resume delivery of vital services to the public, minimize damage and loss to critical processes by protecting essential facilities and resources, reduce or mitigate disruptions to operations, ensure succession if agency leadership is disrupted and improve continuity capabilities

Considering the justifications above, the Committee hereby recommends the following:

1. The adoption of this Committee Report.
2. The approval of the Batangas City Public Service Continuity Plan.


