SUBJECT

Peace and Order and Public Safety (POPS) Plan 2023-2025

Referred to the Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety is the POPS Plan 2023-2025 of Batangas City for study and recommendation.

The POPS Plan is a planning tool which enlists all of the programs of the City Government for the promotion and maintenance of a peaceful and orderly city for the years 2023 to 2025. Areas of concern include (I. Peace and Order) Crime and Disorder prevention, Illegal Drugs eradication and the arrest and prosecution of drug personalities, conflict and insurgency; (II. Public Safety) Road and Vehicular Safety, and Fire Safety.

The objective of the POPS Plan is mainly to enjoin the active cooperation and participation of the communities and of the public, in general, in the programs of the City Government in making Batangas City a peaceful and orderly place to live in. In this manner, the maintenance of peace and order and public safety will be a joint undertaking and obligation of the government and of the people, thereby ensuring more effective results.

For these programs for POPS Plan, the City Government allocates gradually increasing budget for the three-year period: PhP 136,025,000.00 (2023); PhP 138,745,000.00 (2024), and PhP 140,235,000.00 (2025) and the same considerably suggests the inclusion in AIP CY 2023-25.

With the approval of this POPS Plan, the peace and order and public safety course of the city is effectively mapped out.
