**RESOLUTION NO. 22-39 S. 2023**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACCREDITATION OF  
SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, presented before the Sangguniang Panlungsod, were papers of **SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.** for accreditation purposes;

**WHEREAS**, in adherence to the Local Government Code of 1991 as reiterated below, the following provisions were elucidated among the representatives OF **SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.** during the committee hearing held on January 24, 2023 at the OCVAS Training Center, Batangas City that were attended by the members of the said committee and other members of the Council.

1. Chapter 4. - Relations with People's and Non-governmental Organizations.

- 1.1 Section 34. Role of People's and Non-governmental Organizations. - Local Government Units shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy.
- 1.2 Section 35. Linkages with People's and Non-governmental Organizations. - Local Government Units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and

livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people.

- 1.3 Section 36. Assistance to People's and Non-governmental Organizations. - A Local Government Unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction.

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Accreditation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has scrutinized the papers of **SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.** in order to find out whether this NGO is qualified for accreditation and membership in the Local Special Bodies;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod thru the Committee on Accreditation has approved the accreditation of **SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.** as accredited NGO in the Sangguniang Panlungsod, after having found to have complied with all the necessary requirements for this purpose.


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled to approve, as it is hereby approves, the application for Accreditation of **SPECTRUM BARAKO 1200 BASE BATANGAS CHAPTER, INC.** in the City of Batangas.

#### COMMITTEE REPORT

TO: **THE HONORABLE VICE MAYOR ATTY. ALYSSA RENEE A. CRUZ & THE HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD MEMBERS**

SUBJECT: Application for Accreditation of

- Spectrum Barako 1200 Base Batangas Chapter, Inc.
- Julian Pastor Memorial Market Vendors Credit Cooperative
- Metro Batangas United Truckers Group (MBUTG) Inc.
- Philippine Rescue Volunteers Association – Batangas City (PRVABC)
- Citizens Crime Watch (CCW)
- Batangas City Girl Scout Council
- Batangas City Jeepney Operators and Drivers Association
- Bucal Multi-purpose Cooperative

The Committee called a Committee Hearing for the purpose of evaluating the qualifications of the applicant for accreditation, and to reiterate the provisions of the Local Government Code and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and to provide other clarificatory guidelines relative to the accreditation of people's organizations, non-governmental organizations and other organized groups, and in the selection of their representatives to the local special bodies.


The committee hearing revolved around the accreditation of people's organization, non-governmental organizations and similar aggrupations, which focused on the coverage, purpose, accreditation process and requirements and other related guidelines. The committee finds that the applicant substantially complied with the requirements of the law for accreditation except Batangas Jeepney Operators and Drivers Association that meet all the criteria under Items 4.3.1.2 to 4.3.1.4 of Memorandum Circular No. 2022-083, and pass all the requirements stated in Items 4.2.3.1 to 4.2.3.8, except the Certificate of Registration or existing valid Certificate of Accreditation from Any NGA (or in the case of IPOs, certification issued by NCIP).

The committee hereby recommends:


