WHEREAS, according to Section 4.1.2.2 of the DepEd Joint Memorandum Circular 01 S. 2017 (Revised Guidelines on the Use of the Special Education Fund), acquisition and titling of school sites is acceptable;

WHEREAS, in a letter dated February 16, 2023, City Mayor Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha requests to pass a resolution regarding the purchase of property for the expansion of Sto. Niño National High School situated in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Batangas City;

WHEREAS, the parcel of land needed for the expansion is One Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen (1,316) square meters, more or less;

WHEREAS, the sole purpose of the purchase of land is for the expansion of Senior High School in Sto. Niño National High School, Sto. Niño, Batangas City;

WHEREAS, the request is deemed vital in support of education and welfare of the youth, especially the students of Sto. Niño National High School;

FINDINGS:

The Committee on Education, its members, and the Sangguniang Panlungsod members briefly made an overview of the subject and hereby finds the following:

1. The proponent shall be able to give pertinent documents that are necessary for the acquisition of lot in Brgy. Sto. Niño for the expansion of Sto. Niño National High School;

2. The purchasing of property is possible; however, the fund that will be utilized shall be identified;
3. The DepEd Joint Memorandum Circular 01 s. 2017 (Revised Guidelines on the Use of Special Education Fund) states that:

4.1.2 Construction and repair of school buildings:

4.1.2.1 Construction, repair and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities for public elementary and secondary schools, which are deemed to have shortage of classrooms or of other facilities, as the case may be, per DepEd classroom deployment analysis, subject to existing standards/specifications set by DepEd and/or Department of Public Works and Highways; furthermore, this item shall be given priority in the SEE Budget; and

4.1.2.2 Acquisition and titling of school sites

4. Section 272 of the Local Government Code states that the proceeds of the additional 1% SEF Tax shall be automatically released to the Local School Board; and that the proceeds shall be allocated for the operation and maintenance of public schools, construction and repair of school buildings, facilities and equipment, educational research, purchase of books and periodicals, and sports development as determined and approved by the Local School Board.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Considering that the committee finds no legal impediments, the same hereby recommends:


1. The adoption of this committee report; and
2. The approval of the resolution hereto attached.
