#### COMMITTEE REPORT

SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR LOCATIONAL CLEARANCE OF ST. PETER CHAPELS SOUTHERN LUZON, INC. FOR THE PROPOSED TWO-STOREY FUNERAL CHAPELS WITH CREMATORIUM AND EMBALMING FACILITY PROJECT TO BE LOCATED IN BARANGAY CONCEPTION, BATANGAS CITY

#### BACKGROUND

The letter from City Mayor Beverley Rose A. Dimacuha endorsing the application for Locational Clearance of the Proposed Two-Storey Funeral Chapel with Crematorium and Embalming Facility Project of St. Peter Chapels Southern Luzon, Inc. to be located in Barangay Conception, Batangas City was referred to the Joint Committees on Environment, Urban Development, Land Use and Zoning and on Engineering and Public Works last May 9, 2023 during the Regular Meeting of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Batangas.

The Committee Hearing regarding the subject matter was conducted by the aforementioned Joint Committees on May 23, 2023 at 10:15 in the morning was attended by the following: Coun. Armando Lazarte - Chairman, Committee on Environment and Urban Development, Land Use and Zoning; Coun. Lorenzo Gamboa, Jr. - Chairman, Committee on Engineering and Public Works; Coun. Nestor Dimacuha; Coun. Isidra Atienza; Coun. Karlos Emmanjuel Buted; Coun. Nelson Chavez; SK Fed. Pres. Marjorie Manalo; Coun. Oliver Macatangay; Coun. Jose Jonash Luis Tolentino; Coun. Hamilton Blanco; ABC Pres. Angelito Dondon Dimacuha; Coun. Michael Villena; and Vice Mayor Alyssa Renee Cruz.

Also in attendance were Engr. Roselyn Berberabe, Zoning Officer IV and Engr. Edgar Festijo, Assistant CPDC of the City Planning and Development Office; Ms. Marlyn Velasco from the City ENRO; Ms. Guadalupe Judy Tumambing, City Assessor; Engr. Elisha Dimayuga and Mr. Leonelle Quinio from the City Health Office, Engr. Apolonio Calpito from the City Engineer's Office, Barangay Councilor Nely Macatangay and Ms. Jenny Pantua, Barangay Treasurer of Conception, Batangas City, and from the proponent: Mr. Alejandro Martinez, Consultant; Mr. Julius Ramos, Marketing Head; Mr. Rafael Sedara, Branch Manager; Ms. Magdalena Acela Macarilay, Regional Manager.

#### DISCUSSIONS AND OBSERVATIONS

The following observations resulted after extensive discussions and deliberations of all present during the Committee Hearing, to wit:

- 1. Resolutions from the Barangays were vague and should reflect the concerns of the host Barangays, such as the impact in the Barangay with corresponding mitigation and, Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) for such obligations and responsibilities to be legally binding and for transparency purposes. A revised Barangay Resolution shall be passed and a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) shall be signed by and between the proponent and the Barangays concerned, copies of which shall be submitted to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Batangas as provided for by R.A. 7160, Sec. 33;
- 2. The proponent shall design a plan for the continuous treatment of waste water including the detailed disposal and management of odor pollution;
- 3. The proponent shall address the following concern: water reservoir; disposal of liquid waste and monitoring of toxicity; smoke stacks and air pollution; and reassessment of the land;
- 4. All conditions in the Evaluation Report of the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall be complied with, failing to do so shall be sufficient grounds for revocation of the permit.

#### II. SITE DESCRIPTION

1. The project site is located along the President P. Laurel national highway beside the existing Eternal Gardens Memorial Park-Concepcion.

- 2. The existing structure within the project site includes a one storey residential building with two garage and high concrete perimeter fence which will be demolished to give way to the construction of the project.
- 3. The project site has a relatively flat terrain and planted with mango, sampaloc, coconut tree and banana plant.
- 4. The project site is bounded by the following:
  - North Eternal Gardens Memorial Park/ Cemetery/Memorial Park Zone (C/MP-Z)
  - East President Jose P. Laurel National Highway/ Industrial 1-Mixed Use Zone (I1MX-Z)
  - West Residential Houses/ Cemetery/Memorial Park Zone (C/MP-Z)
  - South Vacant Lot/ Cemetery/Memorial Park Zone (C/MP-Z)

#### III. EVALUATION OF FACTS

- 1. The abovementioned project site is within the designated Cemetery/Memorial Park Zone (C/MP-Z) as per the Batangas City Integrated Zoning Ordinance CY-2019, an area intended for the interment of the dead and complementary/supplementary funeral establishment, such as:
  - Memorial Parks
  - Cemetery
  - Columbarium
  - Crematorium
  - Ossuary
  - Customary accessory uses such as funeral parlors, crypts, chapels, parks, playgrounds, pocket parks, parkways, promenades, parking, and toilet facilities
- 2. The office of the Sangguniang Barangay of Concepcion, this city passed Resolution No. 44 Series of 2022 on August 12, 2022 allowing St. Peter Chapels Southern Luzon, Inc. to construct a Two-Storey Funeral Chapel with Crematorium and Embalming Facility in Purok 4, Barangay Concepcion, Batangas City.
- 3. The Punong-Barangay of Barangay Concepcion, Batangas City issued a barangay clearance dated April 11, 2023 allowing the construction of Two-Storey Funeral Chapel with Crematorium and Embalming Facility within the jurisdiction of their barangay.
- 4 The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)- Batangas II, District Engineering Office, Regional Office IV-A, Kumintang Ilaya, Batangas City issued a clearance thru Mr. Alejandro S. Martines on February 09, 2023 that the proposed project of St. Peter Chapels Southern Luzon, Inc. in Barangay Concepcion is 20.50 meters away from the existing road center line and outside the 20.00 meters DPWH road-right-of-way (RROW) limit where in the request has been approved.
- The City Transportation Development & Regulatory Office (TDRO) approved and granted a clearance for the project on January 31, 2023 for the site development plan, parking layout and the projects' traffic management plan.

- 6 Concepcion Rural Waterworks and Sanitation Association issued a certification dated March 3, 2023 that the water source No.3 within the vicinity of Eternal Garden has a distance of 70.00 meters away from the location of the above mentioned project site.
- 7 The project through its proponent has secured Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC-OL-R4A-2022-10-07301) dated October 06, 2022 from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources- Environmental Management Bureau (DENR-EMB) for its crematory & funeral parlor with embalming facility.
- 8 Based on the submitted documents, a sewage treatment plant will be built solely for the operation of embalming room facility. Material Recovery Facility (MRF) will be used for the proper segregation of solid waste of the proposed project.
- 9 The Entrance and exit road will be separated as indicated on the projects' Traffic Management Plan. One-way flow of vehicles coming in and out of the premises and will properly be implemented.
- 10 As per submitted plan, a total of 68 parking slots will be provided within the project site which comply with the parking requirements of the proposed project indicated on Article VII, Section 27 of the Batangas City Integrated Zoning Ordinance 2019.
- 11 As per submitted plan, other facilities to be constructed within the project site are as follows:
  - Genset Room
  - Material Recovery Facility (MRF)
  - Pump Room
  - Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP)

#### IV. CONDITIONS

The evaluation report with reference to the standard requirements submitted to the Zoning Division of the City Planning and Development Office regarding the application for Zoning/Locational Clearance of St. Peter Chapels Southern Luzon, Inc. for its proposed Two Storey Funeral Chapel with Crematorium and Embalming Facility in Barangay Concepcion, this city, is being submitted with the endorsement of the Honorable City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate action but not limited to the following considerations:

- 1. The applicable requirements of all concerned government agencies and applicable provisions of existing laws and city ordinances shall be complied with:
- 2. No expansion, alteration and/or improvement shall be introduced at the project site without prior clearance and permit from the city government;
- 3. The proponent shall secure the required City Environmental Certificate from the City Environment and Natural Resources Office (City ENRO) prior to the start of the construction of the proposed project;
- 4. The proponent shall secure Clearance/Sanitary Permit from the City Health Office (CHO) prior to the operation of the project;
- 5. The proponent shall strictly comply with the applicable provisions of the Sanitation Code of the Philippines (PD 856) and the Batangas City Environment Code (E-Code), the Water Code of the Philippines (PD 1067), Clean Water Act of the Philippines of 2004 (RA 9275), Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003),

Clean Water Act of 2004 (RA 9275), Clean Air Act of 1999 (RA 8749) and the National Building Code of the Philippines (PD 1096);

- 6. The proponent shall pay all the required taxes and fees to be imposed by the city government;
- 7. The proponent shall allow at any time even without prior notice, authorized city government officials/employees to conduct an on-the-spot inspection and monitoring of the on-going activities being undertaken within the project site;
- 8. The proponent shall comply with the provisions of City Ordinance No. 8 Series of 1994, otherwise known as "Providing Priority in Employment or Work to Qualified Barangay Residents;
- 9. The proponent shall maintain the provided access to Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) within the project site in accordance with Batas Pambansa Bilang 344 otherwise known as the Accessibility Law and Republic Act No. 7277 otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons;
- 10. The proponent shall strictly comply with all the conditions and restrictions setforth on the clearance issued on February 09,2023 by the Department of Public Works and Highway (DPWH);
- 11. The proponent shall comply with the rules and regulations being implemented by the Transportation Development and Regulatory Office (TDRO) regarding the traffic regulations within the immediate vicinity of the project site;
- 12. The transfer of ownership of the project carries with it the responsibility of complying with all the abovementioned conditions, the transfer of which shall be made known to this office through a written notification by herein grantee within fifteen (15) days from such transfer;
- 13. Any complaint found valid against the construction and operation of the proposed project shall be sufficient ground for the cancellation and termination of this decision/clearance;
- 14. Any misrepresentation, false statement or allegation material to the issuance of the locational clearance for the proposed project shall be sufficient ground or basis for its revocation;

15. By IPSO FACTO the proponent failed to comply with any of the abovementioned conditions, it shall be ground for the cancellation or revocation of the granted zoning/locational clearance.
