RESOLUTION NO. 22-425 S. 2023

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE LOCALIZED PEACE ENGAGEMENT (LPE) IN
BATANGAS CITY, BATANGAS PURSUANT TO PRESIDENTIAL EXECUTIVE
ORDER NO. 70 SERIES OF 2018**

WHEREAS, the Localized Peace Engagement (LPE) is very important in every Municipality in which it is a mechanism that enables the government not only to directly engage the rebels in the peaceful discourse but also touches base with residents in communities affected by the armed conflict;

WHEREAS, one of the goals of LPE is to strengthen capacities of national and local governance actors to effectively address socio-economic divides, create modalities and strengthen capacities of communities to resist violence and participate in peace building and development in order to achieve community resiliency and cultural harmony;

WHEREAS, Article II of 1987 Constitution states that:

- The Philippines renounces war as an instrument of national policy;
- The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty and poverty and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy and;

- The state shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard living and an improved quality of life for all.

WHEREAS, Presidential Executive Order No. 16, Series of 2017 adopted the National Security Policy 2017-2022 which calls for the end of all armed threats in the Philippines and recognizes that internal socio-political stability rests upon healing the rifts that divided the nation by promoting participatory governance, synergy of government development efforts and enhancing the participation and responsibilities of Local Government Units (LGU);

WHEREAS, upon proper deliberation made by the Honorable Sanggunian, they found out that the Local Government Unit of Batangas City, Batangas should have to support the Localized Peace Engagement (LPE) in this city, pursuant to Presidential Executive Order No. 70, Series of 2018;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled, to support Localized Peace Engagement (LPE) in this city, pursuant to Presidential Executive Order No. 70 Series of 2018, that intends to facilitate the process from the bottom level of locality or community.
